Create a wish list

Now that you have a copy of the programme it's a good idea to make a list of all the events you would like to attend – be prepared and have a backup plan in case your first (and second) choice has sold out.

We will be operating a queuing system again this year and there are likely to be long waiting times.

- Joining the queue on multiple devices is not advised as it will add increased pressure on the box office
- Use the search bar to find events quickly

Purchasing Tickets


- Once you have added your first item to your basket you have 20 minutes to complete your order and check out
- Each order can include a maximum of 10 tickets during the initial busy period
- For events with a capacity of 20 or less, you can purchase up to 2 tickets. For events with more than 20, up to 4 tickets

Checkout

Important Information:

All customers should use the 'Checkout as guest' option even if you created an account last year.

If you try to sign in to an account or create an account you will be pushed through the standard reset password flow which will direct you off the Box Office website.
